SECTION 4 **FIRST AID MEASURES**

INHALATION: This product is not deemed to be an inhalation toxicant, however, in cases of inhalation toxication, remove person from contaminated area to fresh air.

SKIN: This product is not deemed to be a skin irritant, however, in cases of skin irritation, remove contaminated clothing and shoes. Gently wipe off excess chemical. Wash skin gently and thoroughly with water and non-abrasive soap. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

EYES: This product is not deemed to be an eye irritant, however, in cases of eye irritation, flush eyes with clean water for at least 15 – 20 minutes. Lift eyelids to facilitate irrigation. If present, remove contact lenses after 5 minutes and continue rinsing. Seek medical attention if irritation persists.

INGESTION: This product is not deemed to be an ingestion toxicant; however, care needs to be taken when handling this product. In cases of ingestion, do not induce vomiting. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Obtain medical attention immediately. Qualified medical personnel should perform administration of oxygen. If the person is alert, rinse mouth thoroughly with water and give person large volumes of water or milk to drink. When vomiting occurs, keep head lower than hips to prevent aspiration.

SECTION 5

FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

Suitable Extinguishing Media:	Water spray, fog, alcohol resistant foam, dry chemical or carbon dioxide.
Unsuitable Extinguishing Media:	High volume water jet. Use a water jet only to cool heated containers.
Specific hazards:	None known
Special Fire Fighting Procedures:	Remove spectators from surrounding area. Isolate the fire area and evacuate all personnel downwind of the fire. Fight fire from maximum distance and use unmanned hose holder or monitor nozzles. Keep upwind. Avoid inhaling hazardous vapours and fumes from burning materials. Remove container from fire area if possible and without risk. Do not use high volume water jet, due to contamination risk. Do not scatter the burning material. Water can be used to cool unaffected containers but must be contained for later disposal. Contain fire control agents for later disposal. Avoid pollution of waterways by run-off from the site.
Personal protective equipment:	Wear NIOSH/MSHA approved self-contained breathing apparatus and full protective gear.

SECTION 6 **ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES**

Personal Precautions:	Do not breathe in spray mist or fumes. Ventilate area of spill or leak, especially in contained areas.
Protective equipment:	Refer to Section 8 for personal protective equipment to be worn during containment and clean-up of a spill involving this product.
Emergency procedures:	Alert emergency personnel, evacuate unprotected personnel and animals.
Environmental Precautions:	Prevent spilled product from entering sewers, waterways or ground water. Any spillages or uncontrolled discharges into water sources should be reported immediately to the police and the Department of Water/Environmental Affairs.
Methods & Materials for Containment:	Contain spilled product by diking area with sand or earth.
Methods & Materials for Clean-up:	Cover contained spill with an inert absorbent material such as sand, vermiculite, earth or other appropriate material. Vacuum, scoop, or sweep up material and place the material into a clean, dry, sealable container. Label containers with the contents and dispose of according to local regulations. Do not place spilled material back in original container. Do not re-use spill material. Collect washings and add to the drums already collected. Do not flush spilled material or washings into drains or waterways. To decontaminate the spill area, tools and equipment, wash with water and suitable detergent. See section 13 for disposal considerations.

SECTION 7

HANDLING AND STORAGE

HANDLING

Precautions for safe handling: Ensure adequate ventilation during handling and use. Do not handle broken packages without protective equipment. Immediately clean up spills that occur during handling. Keep containers closed when not in use.

General occupational hygiene: Practice good hygiene when using this material. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, smoking, using the toilet or applying cosmetics. Worker should shower at the end of each workday. Launder all clothing before it is re-used.

STORAGE

Conditions for safe storage: Store at temperatures between 15°C and 25°C and relative humidity between 40% and 80%. Do not expose to temperatures higher than 25°C as it can cause a decrease in bacterial viability. Do not store together with food, beverages or animal feed. Keep in all cases the integrity of the original package. Do not expose to sunlight, rain or other meteorological agents that could alter the original characteristics of the product. Do not transport and/or store together with products that could emanate toxic fumes.

Shelf life Maximum of six months.

Permissible concentration: No occupational exposure limits have been determined for the significant ingredients in this product.

Waste: Open dumping or burning of this product is prohibited. Waste resulting from the use of this product cannot be reused or re-processed.
